THANK YOU for your faithfulness to our ministries—through your prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness. As we reach the midpoint of the year, giving and fundraisers for our general ministries has raised \$82,000, with \$90,000 in expenses. Thankfully, due to generous end of year giving, we carried a surplus into 2024, which has enabled us to pay our expenses and still have \$14,000 in our general ministry account. We began the year with \$1,000 in our account to be used for our mortgage payments on the Fellowship Hall and Education Wing, and that debt reduction account now has \$8,700 to be used for those bills.

We need to maintain a regular weekly income of \$4,000 per week toward the regular budget and the debt reduction combined in order to meet our expenses without depleting the accounts. We are currently averaging only \$3312 in income, including fundraisers. If you are able to give regularly toward our ministry—or to make a one-time donation—that goes a long way to sustaining the work that we do together to serve our community.
