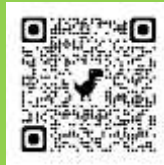
FAITH FRIENDSHIP MINISTRIES is a Faith based group home in Mountville, PA that houses adults with disabilities and mental illnesses. They need craft supplies for their activity department: t-shirts, white baseball hats, tie dye supplies, stickers, holiday stickers, holiday craft supplies for all holidays, poster board, tissue paper, glitter, sequins, yarn, and any other craft supplies anyone wants to donate.

THANK YOU for your faithfulness to our ministries—through your prayers, presence, gifts, service and witness. As of July 31, giving and fundraisers for our **general ministries has raised \$95,903**, with **\$105,647 in expenses**. That **\$10,000 deficit is significant and we need to work to make up that in fundraisers and giving as we move back into the fall and people return from summer vacations.** Thankfully, due to generous end of year giving, we carried a surplus into 2024, which has enabled us to pay our expenses and still have funds in our **general ministry account (\$12,547)**. We also need to continue to support our debt reduction fund which is used for mortgage payments on the Fellowship Hall and Education Wing. **That debt reduction account now has \$13,337.** However, September 1 we will begin repaying the principal and interest at \$3,336.09 per month (we had been required to only pay interest for the last few months).

We need to maintain a regular weekly income of \$4,100 per week toward the regular budget and the debt reduction combined in order to meet our expenses without depleting the accounts. We are currently averaging only \$3938 in income, including fundraisers. If you are able to give regularly toward our ministry—or to make a one-time donation—that goes a long way to sustaining the work that we do together to serve our community.

Gifts can be directed to **General Ministry and/or the Debt Reduction / Building Fund.** Mark preferences in the memo line & envelope. You can also **mail or place an offering in the plate.** Special gifts from IRAs, stocks, etc. can also be received.
