FINANCIAL UPDATE: As of April 30, we have received gifts of \$64,327 and incurred \$72,998 in expenses. Our Checking Account = \$27,453.55 and Mortgage/Debt Reduction Account = \$2,671. We have almost \$67,785 saved in other restricted funds. Our current debt on our mortgage is approx. \$383,000. As you consider what to give, we recommend ¾ of your offering being allocated to the General Ministry Fund and ¼ of your gift to the Mortgage/Debt Reduction Fund. *For example, if you give \$100 per week, we recommend \$75 to General Ministry and \$25 to Mortgage/Debt Reduction.*

FINANCIAL PLANNING: Did you know that you could leave a gift to the church in your will—along with a testimony that shares a statement of faith with your family and friends? 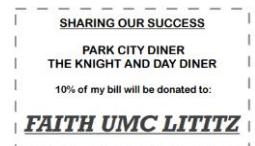

Their retail store is at 31 Rohrerstown Road, Lancaster. The donation center entrance is on Good Drive and is open Mon – Sat, 9AM-6PM. **Our partner number is 10221. Make sure to tell the staff at the door that you're there to credit your donations to a Nonprofit Partner - Faith United Methodist Church before they unload.** It is helpful to tape a note with our partner number to the outside of the bag or place it inside each bag.
